## THE UNIVERSITY

The Annual Report for the academic session 2020-21 of the University attempts to reflect the various facets of the University and its colleges. As is expected of an academic institution, Teerthanker Mahaveer University has grown steadily in terms of its infrastructure and addition of contemporary courses with a dynamic curriculum.

Teerthanker Mahaveer University is a Jain Minority State Private University established by Act No. 30 of 2008 of the Government of Uttar Pradesh and has been approved by University Grants Commission (UGC) under Section 2(f) and UGC (Establishment of and Maintenance of Standards in Private University) Regulations, 2003. The university is located on Old National Highway-24 and is barely 144 Kms from National Capital, New Delhi. The University stands committed to the ideals of Lord Mahaveer i.e. Right Philosophy, Right Knowledge, and Right Conduct in all its operations and aspire to be recognized as premier institutions in India and abroad.

The University owes its origin to Teerthanker Mahaveer Institute of Management and Technology (TMIMT), which forayed into professional education in the year 2001 by offering courses such as BBA, BCA, MCA, MBA and B.Ed. After the university came into existence in 2008, these programs are being run under the TMIMT College of Management, College of Computing Sciences & Information Technology and College of Education. Subsequently, colleges/departments like: Dental, Medical, Engineering, Pharmacy, Nursing, Para-medical Sciences, Physiotherapy, Law, Physical Education, Polytechnic, Fine Arts, Jain Studies and Agriculture Sciences have been created to meet the rising aspirations of the youth. Currently, the University offers wide range of programs having high employability potential through its 14 on-campus colleges and 2 independent departments. The University has made extensive collaborative arrangements with leading national and international institutions to ensure quality education.

The existence of any university lies in the creation of new knowledge through research in order to improve the lives of people. For strengthening the research in the larger interest of the society and to provide a platform to its faculty and researchers to share their research experience and innovations with the world, the University is publishing six in-house research journals viz. **Viewpoint** in Management, **S&T Review** in Engineering, **Pharmacoarena** in Pharmacy, **TMU Journal of Dentistry** in Dental Sciences, **Acta Medica International** in the Medical Sciences, and **IJRTCSIT** in Computer Science disciplines.

The university is NAAC accredited, found its place amongst the top 200 (151-200) universities in NIRF ranking of 2017 and has several awards and recognitions to its credit. With the confidence reposed, by all its stakeholders, in the progress and the contribution of the university, TMU enjoys a unique position to facilitate the all round development of students to help them acquire the ability of lifelong learning and to make them competent professionals as well as good human beings.

The beautifully landscaped campus spread over 140 acres of land has the uniqueness of many majestic buildings, large lawns, well maintained playgrounds alongwith

supporting facilities to generate vibrancy and sense of purpose in the campus. It has been planned, designed and constructed to address broader issues that relate to resource and energy conservation. Concepts such as rain water harvesting, sewage treatment, development of water bodies, green parks and pathways, plantations and use of solar energy have been applied.

The facilities such as air-conditioned lecture theaters, language labs, Wi-Fi connectivity, well stocked libraries with access to e-journals, advance computer centres, modern and well-equipped laboratories, ultra modern auditorium, contemporary seminar halls, community centres, open air theaters, indoor & outdoor sports complexes and recreation facilities provide distinct advantage for creating and dissemination of knowledge. Construction of Olympic size swimming pool, post office and shopping complex are planned to further augment the facilities.



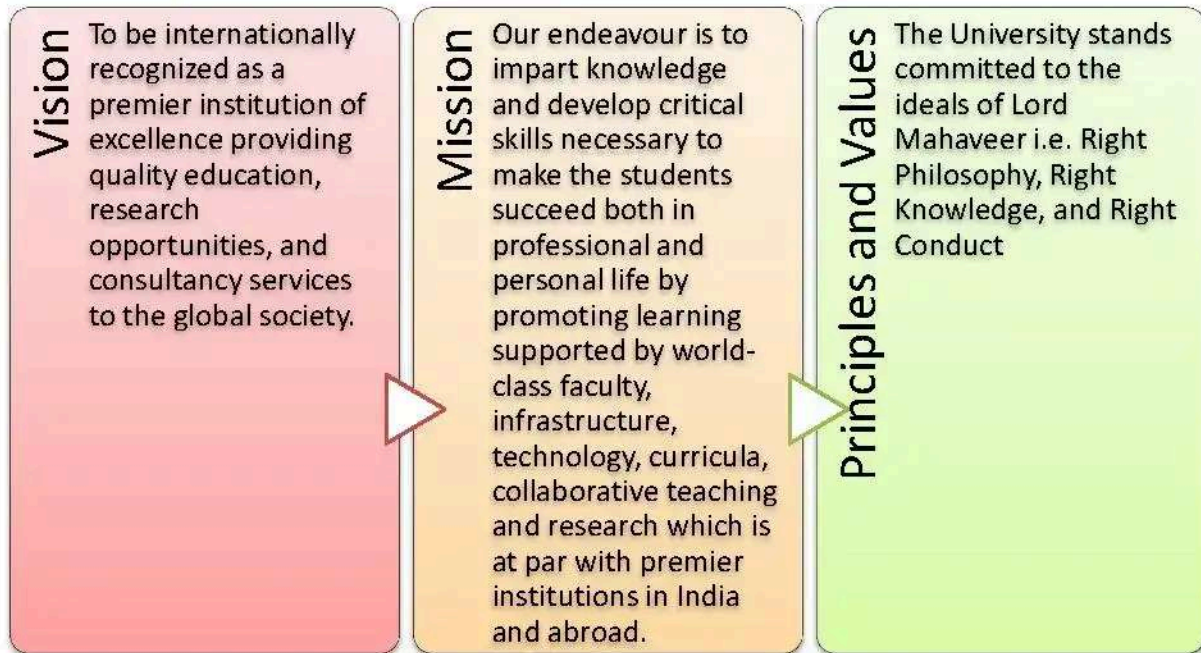

## IT RESOURCES

The University is adequately equipped with computer systems. Each college has dedicated computer lab(s) equipped with general as well as domain specific software for quality teaching and research.



Microsoft ERP installed to automate various administrative processes of the university. The University is proud to be a part of the National Knowledge Network (NKN), an initiative of the Department of Science and Technology and Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India, which connects universities of the country through high speed internet to share knowledge, learning experiences and academic resources.

Additionally, use of Skype and other technology helps eliminate distances and dissolve boundaries, with eminent experts available to interact with students and faculty, allowing for a free flow of knowledge.

## THE LANGUAGE LABS

Four (4) State-of-the-art language labs with 240 computer terminals equipped with hi-tech software, to help develop basic, intermediate and business level language skills. In addition, these labs have personality development cabins and group discussion rooms for students to interact with their peer groups, for discussions and debate, allowing them to grow holistically.

## HOSTEL

There are four separate hostels for boys and girls to accommodate approximately 4600 students. Rooms are spacious, clean, airy and well maintained with attached bathrooms and are available on single as well sharing basis. Each room is furnished with beds, wardrobes, study tables and chairs, air coolers have also been provided for each room. Round-the-clock power back-up facility is available in the campus. Air-conditioned rooms are made available on request. Solar heaters have been installed for providing hot water during winters. Water purifiers and water coolers have been installed to provide potable water.

Each Hostel has a provision for a visitor's room, a spacious well-lit common room with large screen television and comfortable seating arrangement, recreational facilities, equipments for indoor games, newspapers & magazines, wi-fi connectivity and a gymnasium/Laundry facilities are available in-house with provision for commercial washing machine and tumble drier.



## CAFETERIA

Besides Central Mess facilities and well-maintained canteens, 'The Bicano' has been started for providing hygienic, moderately priced and delicious food items to the students. Indian, Chinese & Italian dishes are also part of menu in this restaurant.



## SHOPPING CENTRE

There is a shopping centre in the campus for the convenience of the students and university residents. There are number of stores catering to necessary commodities such as books, stationary items, fruits, vegetables and grocery items.

## GUEST HOUSE

The University has a guest house having well furnished rooms with all facilities like attached bathroom, geyser, air conditioner, colour television etc. in each room catering to the requirements of visiting/guest faculty, other resource persons, as well as parents of students.

## TRANSPORTATION

TMU has arranged a pick and drop transportation facility to students within a radius of about 100Km from adjoining areas of the city of Moradabad. It presently maintains 54 Buses, 17 Cars, 5 Ambulances including 2 Critical Care Ambulances, 4 Small Trucks for carriage and 2 Tractors with Trolleys and 2 Tankers for agriculture and plantation purposes in the campus.

## AUDITORIUM

The state-of-the-art auditorium with a capacity of 550 seats having ultra modern acoustics and digital projection is now frequently used by constituent Colleges of the University to organize international, national, inter & intra college events like seminars, conferences, debates, theatres, exhibitions and cultural programs. The centrally air conditioned auditorium has been constructed at an approximate cost of Rs. 8.00 Crores. It is equipped with the most modern light system, music system, stage control system and eco-proof.

## HEALTH FACILITIES

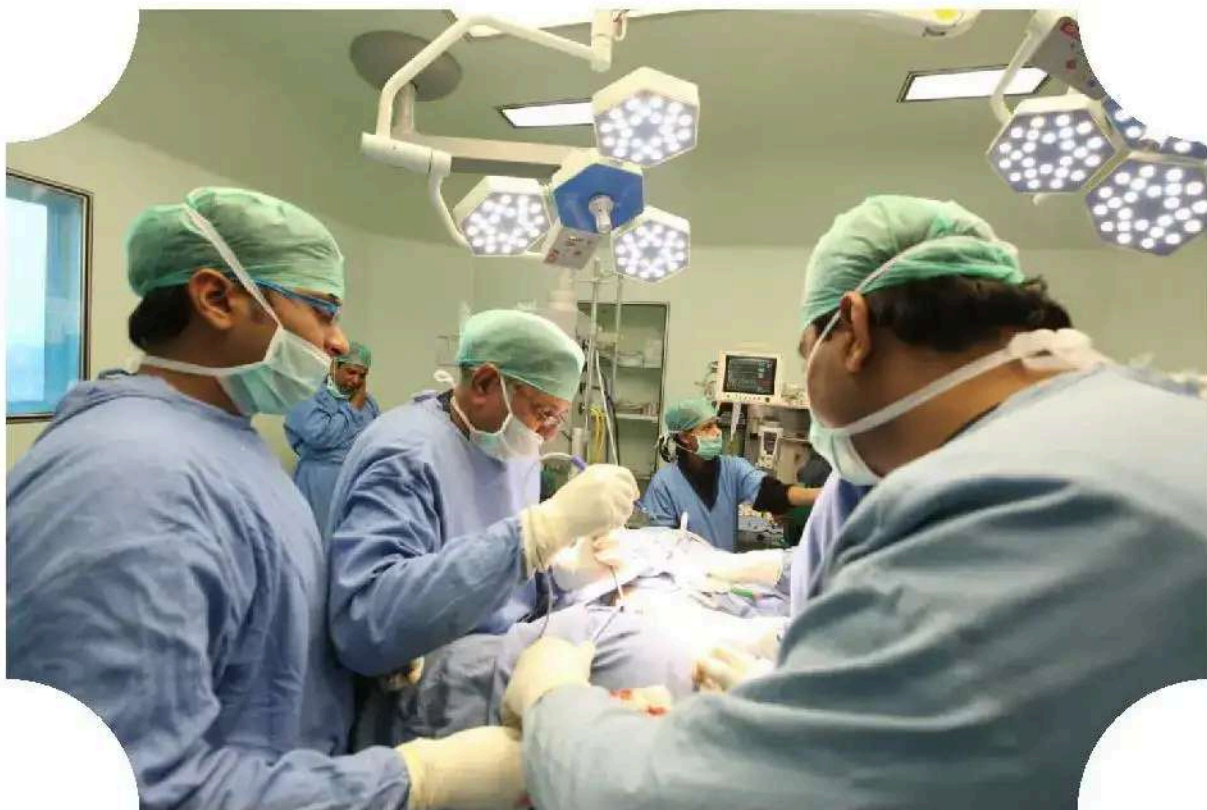
Teerthanker Mahaveer University has 800 bed Multi Specialty and Super Specialty hospital in the campus attached to its Medical College.

The hospital caters to medical needs of a vast area of the Moradabad City, Moradabad Rural, Amroha, Sambhal, Chaundasi, Rampur, Bilari, Joya, Kundarki, Gajraula, Thakurdwara, Dilari, Moonda Pandey, Sirsi and Behjoi etc. along with surrounding villages of these areas. Basically, the hospital gives a variable option to the patients coming from western UP and forced to move to Delhi for tertiary level management.



The hospital offers allopathic treatment and has the most modern and well equipped OPDs/Indoor/Emergency/Investigation/Surgical Treatment units. It is being manned by a team of highly qualified and dedicated specialists and super-specialists in different disciplines.

- **Mobile Van:** The hospital provides the facility of fully equipped Mobile Van which takes care of the critical patients.
- **Intensive Care:** Critical Care facilities are available in Intensive Care Unit (ICU), Intensive Coronary Care Unit (ICCU), Surgical Intensive Care Unit (SICU), Respiratory Intensive Care Unit (RICU), Neo Natal Intensive Care Unit (NICU), Paediatric Intensive Care Unit (PICU), Burn Intensive Care Unit (BICU), Hemodialysis and O.T. Complex.
- **Emergency Services:** For accidents and emergencies, the Casualty Department, is located strategically at the entry of the hospital. It is being manned, round the clock by Casualty Medical Officers backed up by specialists and super specialist doctors on call from each discipline, nurses and para-medical staff. It is equipped with its own X-ray machine, ECG machine, equipment for cardiac monitoring, operation theatre and emergency medicines. The department is supported by the services of Ambulance, Laboratory and Blood Bank round the clock. Medico-Legal cases are also attended.
