LL.M. Programme Details of Programme Structure: The LL.M. Programme is a one year course divided into two semesters. A student has to complete **24** credits for the completion of the course and award of the degree. The scheme is as follows:

❖ **Assessment of Students' Performance and Scheme of Examination Pass Percentage & Promotional Criteria:**

- English/Hindi shall be the medium of instruction and examination.
- Assessment of students' performance shall consist of: 60 marks (End Semester Written Examination) and 40 marks (Internal Assessment).
- The duration of the End Semester Written Examination in Core Courses and Elective Courses shall be three hours for 60 marks.
- For internal assessment of 40 marks, Three internal Test of 1.5 Hour (10 Marks each) +Assignment/Presentation/Viva shall be in the class in each course in each term. (Assignment/Presentation/Viva- 10 Marks & Attendance - 10 marks)

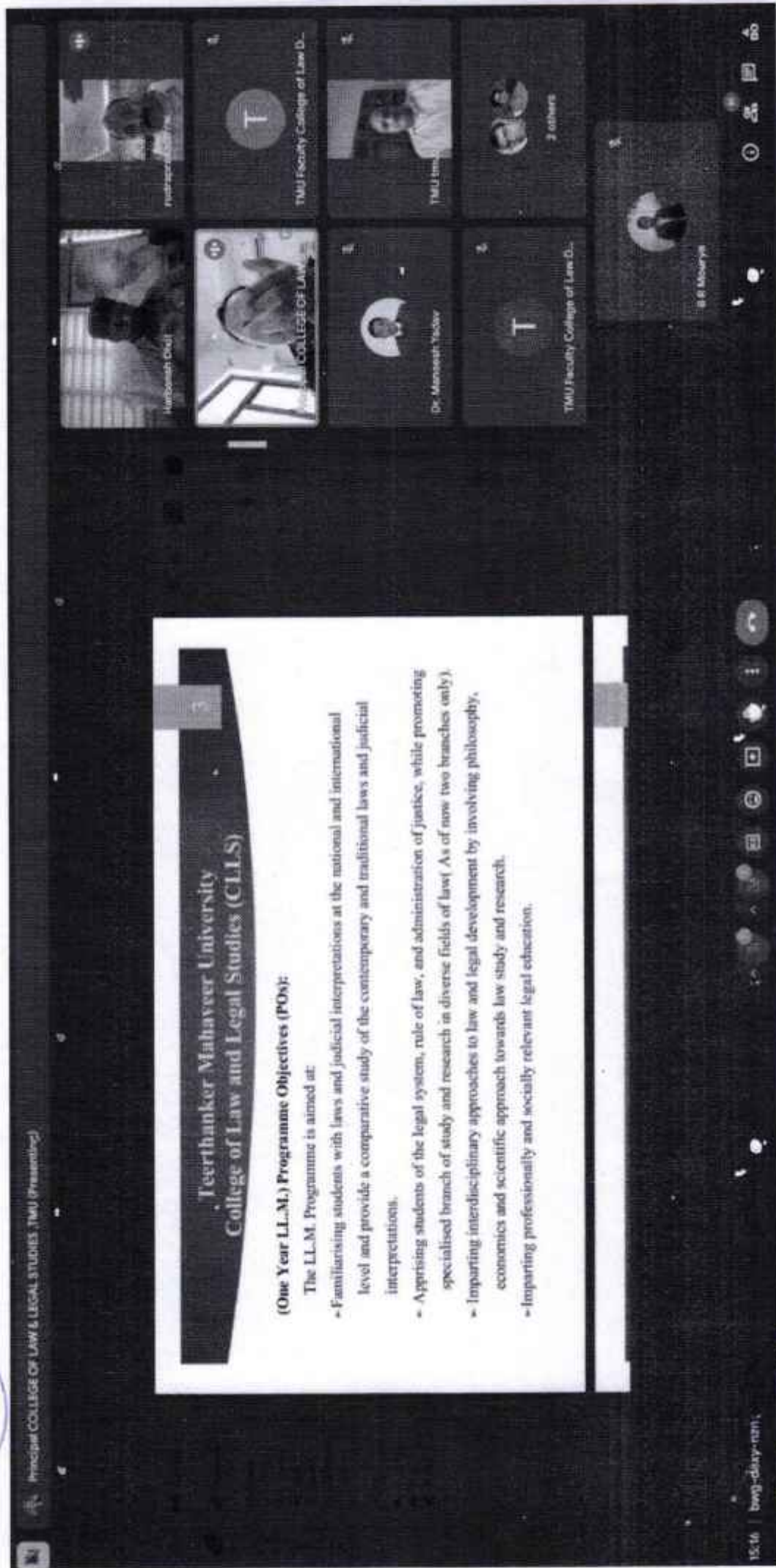


