As per the following decisions were taken:

1. There will be two internal assessments in each phase of study and one pre university examination at the end of phase 3 part 1. Each formative assessment of the students in 1<sup>st</sup> phase will be of 20 marks, in 2<sup>nd</sup> phase of 50marks and in 3<sup>rd</sup> phase of 85 marks. Two practical examinations will be done in phase 3 terminal examination of 50 marks each.
2. End posting formative assessment will be done at end of 4 weeks of posting in 2<sup>nd</sup> phase of 50 marks and end of 6 weeks of posting in 3<sup>rd</sup> phase of 60 marks.
3. The pre university will of same pattern as 3<sup>rd</sup> prof. part –I university examination. Two theory paper of 100 marks each and one practical examination of 100 marks.
4. The total internal assessment in theory will be of 510 marks and in practical will be of 310 marks.
5. The internal assessment will be proportionate into 100 marks of theory and practical separately
6. As per revised curriculum there will be two theory papers of 100 marks each in 3<sup>rd</sup> phase part – I University Examination.

7. The topic distribution for each paper is given below:

8. Each university theory paper will have 15 marks of MCQ/true-false types of question.
9. The remaining 85 marks in each paper will be distributed across 6 questions.
  - a. There will be 3 long essay questions of 15 marks each.
  - b. There will be one long essay question of 10 marks.
10. Each long question must be structured with marks defined for each aspect of the question.
11. There will be one question with write in brief for 15 marks. There will be three different topics under this question.
12. There will be one question with short notes for 15 marks. This will have five different questions. The questions to be framed on a particular aspect of the topic.
13. In practical examination there will be one case presentation along with viva voice of 50 marks. The student will take history and present the case in front of the examiners. The family will be allotted by random selection.
14. The spotting examination will cover aspects of medical entomology, vaccines, nutrition, environment sanitation, maternal care, drugs under various national health programmes, documentation charts etc. Each spot will have two questions of one mark each. There will be a total of 10 spots and entire exercise will be of 20 marks.
15. The epidemiological and statistical problem solving exercise will be of 15 marks each. The entire exercise will be of 30 marks.

16. The panel of external examiner was prepared (Annexure-I).
