



D2. INC was notified that integration of middle-level health provider(MLHP) in Basic BSc Nursing and Post Basic BSc nursing program, students who will be undergoing 4th year BSc nursing and 2nd year Post Basic BSc nursing in the year 2019-20. The committee reviewed and accepted to implement MLHP log book by consulting with CHN department.

- Committee suggested to post students in respective district hospital and community health centres.

D3. INC was circulated new examination guideline of BSc nursing program. The committee reviewed the guidelines and accepted that on completion of internship, internal assessment out of 100 marks should be sent to the university for inclusion in the mark sheet.

- End of the internship clinical postings concerned teachers should conduct end ^{posting} ~~point~~ examination (practical and viva) for 20 marks to each specialty subject, there will be internal and external examiners of the college. All five specialty marks should be added and internal assessment out of 100 marks should be sent to the university for inclusion in the mark sheet.

D4. As per university suggestion for MSc nursing 1st year (2019-20) plan to have OBE course and subject teachers were developed course hand out which was reviewed and approved to have OBE course for MSc 1st year 2019-20.

- Committee accepted the OBE guidelines given by university.

D5. As per university suggestion Center for Teaching, Learning and Development (CTLD) included English and soft skills for nursing students. The committee accepted to include courses along with INC syllabus.

- Committee accepted the English subject as per INC to be continued as a university exam in BSc 1st and PBBSc 1st year. English and soft skills to be kept in 1st, 2nd yr, 3rd yr, and 4th yr BSc and 1st and 2nd yr PBBSc, and examination marks is not included in final marks sheet.
