A discussion was made in the meeting regarding Two Value Added Courses on 'Soft Skills for Professionals' to be introduced in all programs of Faculty of Education from the academic session 2019-20. The value added courses shall be carried out by the **Centre for Teaching, Learning and Development (CTLD)** of University. The courses will remain qualifying in nature and non credit courses. It is compulsory for students to score 45% marks to qualify the course. After a thorough discussion with the experts, the board bestowed its consent for the following courses.

Agenda 5: Introduction of Open Elective/Online Courses

After discussion & deliberations in the meeting two open electives/ online courses (MOOC courses) were added in the programs of more than two years. Students of **B.Sc, B.Sc-B.Ed Integrated, B.A, B.A- B.Ed Integrated and B.El.Ed.** can opt two open electives (MOOC courses) available on the Online Learning Platform offered by UGC in the 5th and 6th Semesters of 3rd year of program. However, out of these two courses, a student can opt one course in Odd semester & the other in Even semester of the same program of the 3rd year.

Agenda 6: Approval of Revised Syllabus of B.Ed., B.Sc, B.Sc-B.Ed Integrated, B.A, B.A- B.Ed Integrated and B.El.Ed.


The members discussed the syllabus with all members and they approved the syllabus of B.Ed., B.Sc /B.Sc -B.Ed Integrated, B.A / B.A- B.Ed. Integrated and B.El.Ed. Programs as per CBCS guidelines given by UGC *w.e.f.* academic session 2019-20 after incorporating a few modifications.

- Hours were assigned for each unit in each course of all programs.
- In Course: Information and Communication Technology of all Programs add topic "E-Learning and Online Classes" in Unit-III and Topic "E-Libraries" shift to unit-V from unit-III.
- In Course: Critical Understanding of ICT" Course Code BED 452 of **Program B.Ed.** add following topics "Creation & Operation of E-mail account and management of Google Drive"; "Use of Audio-Visual Aids Like: Computer, Projector, Android Mobile in education"; "Conduct & Operate at least five Online Learning Classes through Different Application"; "Creation and Operation of You-tube Account for demonstrate five audio/video lectures related to their Pedagogy subject.
- In B.El.Ed. Program one course: Understanding Discipline and Subjects Course Code BELED 401 was added in the Fourth Semester
- A discussion was made with the experts regarding changes in minimum credits since the total credits of programs got modified due to credit change in English communication syllabus and other courses *w.e.f.* academic session 2019-20.
- Credits were finally approved by the experts and board members.
Minimum credit required for B.A./B.Sc. degree is 141, B.A.- B.Ed. / B.Sc.-B.Ed. Integrated degree is 213, B.Ed. degree is 90 and B.El.Ed. degree is 193.

Agenda 7: Any other point with the permission of the chair.

The members discussed **B.A. & B.A. B.Ed.** Program and agreed that one course Political Science core course in the current syllabus has to be changed in to the elective course and the Course History which is the elective course has to be changed in to the core course. The reason is that the subject History is mandatory in the central and state government competitive examinations (TGT- Social Science). This will be effective from academic session 2020-2021.
