




Employer's Feedback Analysis Report AY 2019-20





























Overall Analysis

On the basis of the feedback obtained from different parameters it was analysed that **89%** of employers were very happy that the syllabus was relevant and contemporary while **88%** of them felt very happy that the curriculum balances theoretical as well as practical components. An **92%** felt very happy that the syllabus incorporates provisions for experiential learning, new ideas and techniques. A majority of **87%** were very happy that the curriculum imparts technical knowledge/skill and **87%** felt very happy that the syllabus has components enhancing employability skills. Overall, **93%** of the employers were very happy with the curriculum/syllabus.

Feedbacks from Employer experts were in the form of minor changes in the syllabi. However, few notable suggestions received to enrich the syllabus from various academia professionals are as follows:

- Students to have a provision to enhance knowledge through MOOC courses.
- Students requested to have classes for soft skills enhancement.

The employers are found, to be overall, satisfied with the curriculum/syllabus.
