### OVERALL ANALYSIS

On the basis of the feedback obtained on different parameters, it was analysed that 85% of alumni students stated that the curriculum prescribed for their degree during their term in the college was excellent. Further analysis of other parameters reveals that 90% state that the quality of education imparted in the college was excellent and 85% state that the course content delivery was excellent. On Innovative Teaching-Learning Methodologies on course curriculum, 95% stated that it was excellent in fulfilling their expectations. There was slight variation in the academic initiative taken by college to bridge the gap between industry and academia with 83% rating it as excellent, 15% as very good and 2% as good. The same was observed in rating new skills learnt in the due course of their study with 95% overall stating that it was either excellent or very good. In terms of relevance to their present job, 81% stated it was excellent and 14% stated that it was very good. A huge 90% stated that the supporting academic initiatives like Seminars, Workshops, Projects, Study Tours, etc taken by the colleges to improve the competencies of a student are excellent and 85% rated excellent for development activities organized by the college for their overall development. Overall, 90% stated that they felt motivated to pursue higher education because of the syllabus.

Feedback received from different alumni was specific in terms of new and emerging technologies and trends.

However, few notable suggestions received to enrich the syllabus from various colleges are as follows:

- Alumni of Physiotherapy suggested that Medical Tourism is an emerging trend and knowledge should be imparted in the regular program regarding this.
- Many alumni expressed their interest in obtaining a degree in business and management, specifically related to imports and exports of handicrafts.
- Alumni of Computer Sciences suggested that Data Sciences is an upcoming field and a degree in this would help future students.
