OVERALL ANALYSIS

On the basis of the feedback obtained on different parameters, it was analysed that 85% of employers were happy and very happy that the syllabus was





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relevant and contemporary while all of them felt happy that the curriculum balances theoretical as well as practical components. An 83% felt happy that the syllabus incorporates provisions for experiential learning, new ideas and techniques. A majority of 92% were very happy that the curriculum imparts technical knowledge/skill and 72% felt that the syllabus has components enhancing employability skills. Overall, 88% of the employers were very happy with the curriculum/syllabus.

Feedback received from different employers was related to practical application of the knowledge that the students have on completion of the course.

However, few notable suggestions received to enrich the syllabus from various colleges are as follows:

- Many employers felt that students had knowledge but were not able to apply the knowledge fluently.
- Employers in the field of Teaching felt that the candidate were not clear with what they have learnt and so outcome of their education was not clear.
- A major demand was placed on the need for soft skills and communication improvement.

Other than this, the employers have been found to be overall satisfied with the curriculum/syllabus.

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
