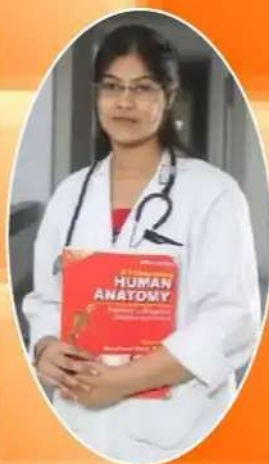

The driving force behind this gigantic task of setting-up the University is Hon'ble Chancellor Sh. Suresh Jain, who

along with the Group Vice-chairman Sh. Manish Jain has been continuously engaged in the 'task to create' the right atmosphere to make it a world-class University – a University which stands for humanism, tolerance, reason, innovations and search for truth. Through its eight colleges and three departments of studies, the university has seen significant increase in students' enrollment from 1065 in 2008-09 to 4023 in 2009-10. 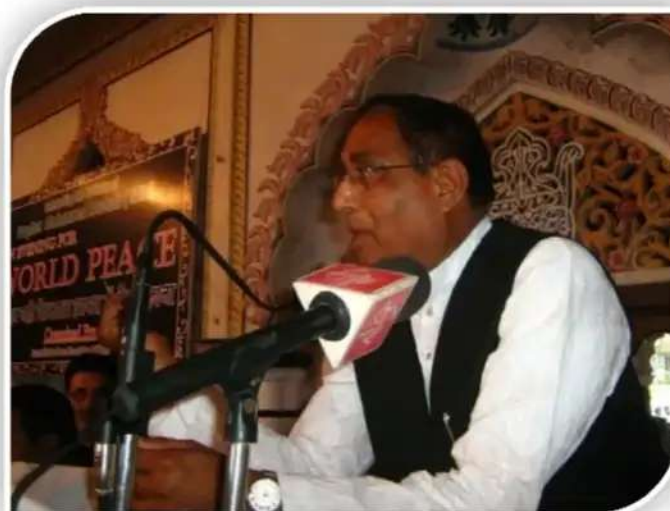

# University Governance

The Teerthanker Mahaveer University Uttar Pradesh Act, 2008 (U.P. Act No. 30 of 2008) sets the governance model for the university. The important bodies of the university are:

## University Court

The primary function of the University Court is to periodically review the broad policies and programs of the university and suggest measures for the efficient functioning and improvement of the university and also to advise the Visitor on the referred matter(s). Recognizing the importance of the body, eminent people who have contributed significantly in their fields have representation in the Court.

## Planning Board

Planning Board is the principal planning body of the university responsible for ensuring the availability of infrastructure and academic support system to meet the norms and requirements of the academic programs as well the regulatory bodies. Persons of eminence having made noteworthy contribution in the corporate world and having deep understanding of requirements of educational sector are representing this august body.

## Executive Council

Executive Council is responsible for general oversight of the university, including its administration. It sets the policy framework for university governance. Certain academic decisions are also subject to the Executive Council's approval including new programs or major changes to programs. 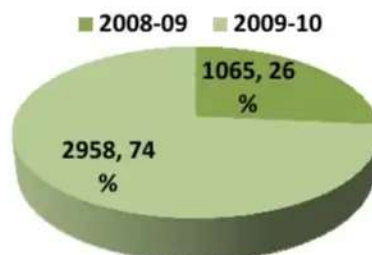

## Guest House

The University has one guest house having 25 well furnished rooms with full facilities like attached bathroom, geyser, air conditioner, television etc. in each room catering to the requirements of visiting and guest faculty as well as parents of students.



## Transportation

There is a fleet of buses, cars, ambulances and others to provide uninterrupted transport facility to the students, faculty and guests.

Presently, University has a fleet of 42 vehicles including 18 luxurious buses (Volvos), 16 cars, two Ambulances which include one critical care ambulance, 4 small trucks for carriage, 2 tractors for agriculture and plantation related activities in the campus. Students from the adjoining area (within a radius of 100 kms) normally avail the transport facility provided. Our buses have the facility of push back seats, hydraulic doors, power windows with the all essential safety measures.





Well maintained cars are being used for administrative use and for picking/dropping our guests visiting the University. Ambulance services on 24 hrs bases are available for patients in the hospital. Critical care ambulance is always ready for shifting patients to Delhi and other places.

For effective transportation, there is a separate transport department managed by skilled officer & staff and well trained drivers.

## Auditorium



The state-of-the art centrally air conditioned auditorium with a capacity of 550 seats having ultra modern acoustics and digital projection is now frequently used by Colleges to host international, national, inter & intra college events like seminars, conferences, debates, theatres, exhibitions and cultural programs. The auditorium has been constructed at an approximate cost of Rs. 8.00 crores. It is equipped with the most modern light system, music system, stage control system and eco-proof etc.

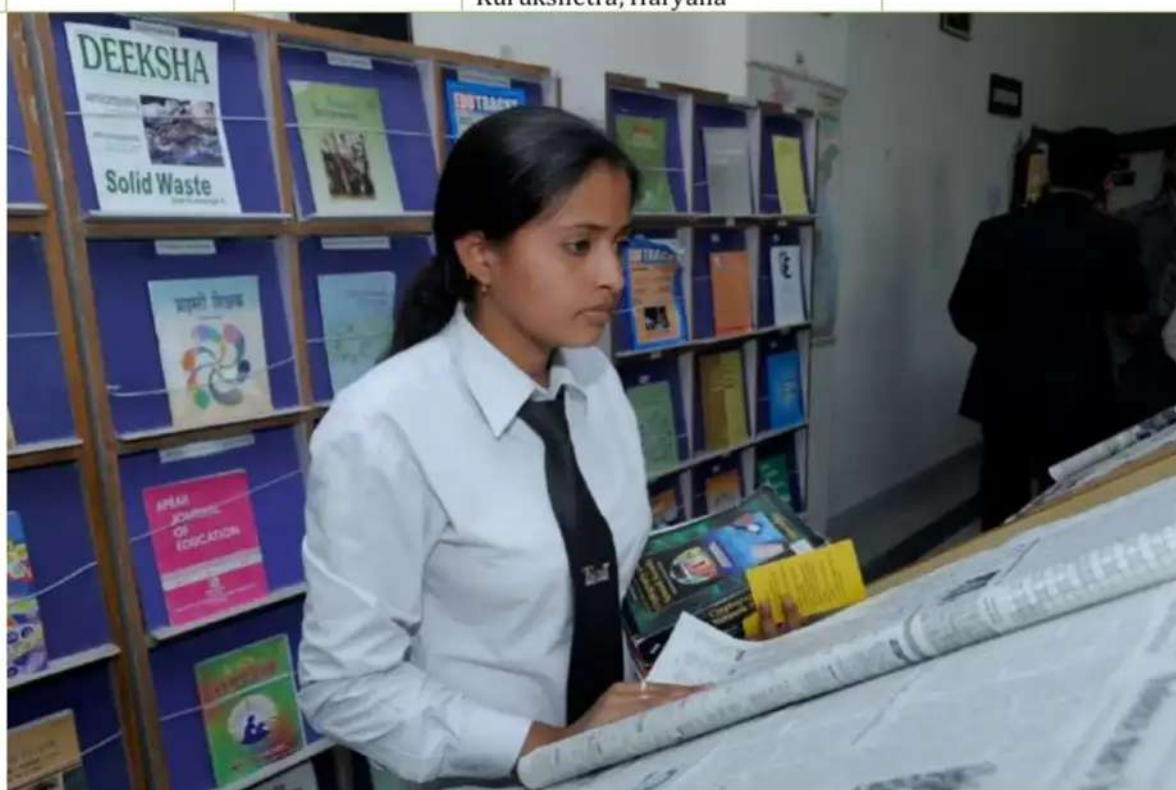
