

# Foreword by the Vice Chancellor

It gives me immense pleasure to present the **III Annual Report** of Teerthanker Mahaveer University for the **Academic Session 2010-2011**. The report is a reflection of phenomenal growth and development in the areas of academics, infrastructure, and contribution of the faculty in research, exhibiting the stupendous work done by its multidisciplinary and cross functional team. Building upon the success achieved in last session, the university continued its voyage on the growth trajectory towards realizing the vision with mission as envisaged by the Founder of University & Hon'ble Chancellor Mr. Suresh Jain.

The most challenging assignment for an institute of higher learning is to attain and retain a team of qualified and experienced academicians with high standard of excellence, and it is gratifying to note that we have been able to build an intellectually strong team working with collective strength and commitment to achieve a sustained high level of performance.

A team of University Grants Commission visited the University in July 2011 to inspect it under the provisions of UGC (Establishment of and Maintenance of Standards in Private Universities) Regulations 2003. It is a matter of pride to note that the team was satisfied with the infrastructure and other facilities thus giving a favourable report.

It has been our sincere endeavor to encourage research in the university. The faculty members are continuously motivated to enthusiastically participate in research projects and assignments. Consequently, the faculty and staff of university published 83 books, 158 research papers in national journals and 81 research papers in international journals. As many as 30 guest lectures, 24 workshops, Seminars, Conferences were organized to provide a platform for exchange of views through deliberations by the scholars par excellence.

In order to integrate the classroom teaching with the practical application of theoretical knowledge and to facilitate hands on experience, the university entered into new academic alliances with Microsoft, Promaynov Executive Trainers LLP, National Stock Exchange, Amtek Auto Ltd., Indian Institute of Logistics, and International School for Jain Studies. During the session 18 new professional courses were introduced and the enrolment of the students grew by a whopping 66% over last year, proportionately there was increase in the strength of the faculty to 693.

For multi dimensional growth of its learners, the university has been actively promoting cultural and sports activities. A three day long cultural event Rock On-III, 13<sup>th</sup> National Youth Volleyball Championship, and 8<sup>th</sup> State Level Junior Wushu Championship are some of the important events organized in the series. Developing infrastructural facilities to meet the growing needs for additional space has always been a priority area for the university and this year has been no exception. The university started the construction of a multipurpose hall with a covered area of 5000 sq.mts. and an Indoor Sports Centre & College of Physical Education with covered area of 6825 sq.mts.

It is my strong conviction that the youth of today need to be empowered with emotional stability, balance and adaptability. We should instill in them sense of values, right direction and purpose of life. Without compromising on the quality of education, we strive to give end to end solution to mitigate the hardships faced by the children coming from the weaker sections of society especially the girl students. Every effort is made to enhance their professional skills for better employment avenues and enabling them to find a meaningful place in the society.

Along with academic activities we recognise our social responsibility and have organized a number of free medical and dental check-up camps and other awareness campaigns from time to time to contribute for healthy India. 





 Eight storeyed new building for College of Nursing with covered area 2,40,000 sq.ft. at an estimated cost of Rs. 1.95 Crores.




Eight storeyed boys hostel for University Polytechnic with covered area 4,80,000 sq.ft. at an

### **Guest House**

The University has one guest house having 25 well furnished rooms with all facilities like attached bathroom, geyser, air conditioner, colour television etc. in each room catering to the requirements of visiting/guest faculty, other resource persons, as well as parents of students.

### **Transportation**

For effective transportation, there is a separate efficient transport department managed by skilled officer & staff and well trained drivers. There is a fleet of buses, cars, ambulances and others vehicles to provide uninterrupted transport facility to the students, faculty and guests.



Presently, University has 42 vehicles including 18

luxurious buses (Volvos), 16 cars, 2 Ambulances which include one critical care ambulance, 4 small trucks for carriage, 2 tractors for horticulture and other such activities undertaken in the campus. The students from the adjoining area (within a radius of 100 kms) normally avail the transport facility provided. The buses are equipped with the facility of push back seats, hydraulic doors, power windows with the all essential safety measures.

Well maintained cars are being used for administrative work and for picking/dropping our guests visiting the University. Ambulance services on 24 hrs. basis are available for patients in the hospital. Critical care ambulance is always ready for shifting patients to Delhi and other places.

#### Auditorium

The state-of-the art auditorium with a capacity of 550 seats having ultra modern acoustics and digital projection is now frequently used by constituent Colleges of the University to organize international, national, inter & intra college events like seminars, conferences, debates, theatres, exhibitions and cultural programs. The centrally air conditioned auditorium has been constructed at an approximate cost of Rs. 8.00 Crores. It is equipped with the most modern light system, music system, stage control system and eco-proof.



## **Sports**

Ample sports facilities have been created in the Campus for the all round development of students. This facilitates individuals to imbibe sportsman sprit, develop social values and to be humble in victory and gracious in defeats. A modern indoor sports complex is under construction at an approximate cost of Rs. 6.21 Crores. The stadium is expected to be functional within six months time.   - 1. Medical students are deployed regularly in the field under the clinical postings for clinic-social activities ranging from 3<sup>rd</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> semester. During the postings as a part and parcel of the academics they are required to impart health education to the member of society on various health issues encountered during their attachment. - Medical social workers are being posted regularly in the Dept. of Community Medicine under the semester training postings. As a part of their training, they are being deployed in the field practice areas of the Dept. of Community Medicine i.e. at RHTC and UHTC centers.
  - During 2010-11, first batch of 20 MSW's was posted and they held various health education sessions in the community on various important health issues. Second batch of 8 students followed thereafter and carried out health education sessions in the community.
- A free health check-up camp was held at Peetal Basti by the doctors of Medical College on Sep. 25, 2010 in which free medicines were given to the needy patients.
- A Flood Relief Camp was organized to help the victims of flood in Kalyanpur, Devapur and



surrounding areas from September 24-27, 2010. A team of doctors and medical students visited the area to help the people. A free medical checkup camp was organized and medicines worth Rs. 1 lac were distributed among 1500 sufferers.

- **C.** A Free Dental check-up and information on dental care and hygiene was organized by the doctors of Dental College at Mohan Public Junior High school on Sep. 09, 2010.
- D. A Social Awareness Camp to inculcate social values was organized by the Department of Social Work on Sep. 24, 2010 at Moradabad.
- **E.** A free Dental Health Checkup Camp was organized in Department of Community Dentistry on June 02, 2011 by the Dental College.

#### **Health Facilities**

Teerthanker Mahaveer University has a 550 bed Multi Specialty and Super Specialty hospital in the campus attached to its Medical College.



The hospital caters to medical needs of a vast area of the Moradabad City, Moradabad Rural, Amroha, Sambhal, Chaundasi, Rampur, Bilari, Joya, Kundarki, Gajraula, Thakurdwara, Dilari, Moonda Pandey, Sirsi and Behjoi etc. along with surrounding villages of these areas. Basically, the hospital gives a variable option to the patients coming from western UP and forced to move to Delhi for tertiary level management.

## Philosophy of the Hospital

The services of this hospital are being provided to all without any distinction of Caste, Creed, Race, Religion, or Language. The economically weak, poor, deserving patients are given medical treatment with the same care and attention at an affordable cost.

### **Facilities in the Hospital**

The hospital offers allopathic treatment and has the most modern and well equipped OPDs/INDOOR/EMERGENCY/INVESTIGATION/SURGICAL TREATMENT units. It is being manned by a team of highly qualified and dedicated specialists and super-specialists in different disciplines. A brief of different facilities is as under:

- Mobile Van: The hospital provides the facility of fully equipped MOBILE VAN which takes care of the critical patients.
- Intensive Care: Critical Care facilities are available in Intensive Care Unit (ICU), Intensive Coronary Care Unit (ICCU), Surgical Intensive Care Unit (SICU), Respiratory Intensive Care Unit (RICU), Neo Natal Intensive Care Unit (NICU), Paediatric Intensive Care Unit (PICU), Burn Intensive Care Unit (BICU), Hemodialysis and O.T. Complex.



- \*Emergency Services: For accidents and emergencies, the Casualty Department, is located strategically at the entry of the hospital. It is being manned, round the clock by Casualty Medical Officers backed up by specialists and super specialist doctors on call from each discipline, nurses and para-medical staff. 


