## Minutes of the meeting:

- 1. The BOS member has agreed that in MFA103 Occidental Aesthetics-1 Philosopher St. Thomas Aquinas is more relevant in place of Dante because this philosopher have a great contribution up on Italian Aesthetics.
- 2. BOS members also agreed that in BFA707 (History of Indian art –II) in Unit IV content is repeated, so board members has decided the few important artist M.F. Hussain, Amrita Shergil and Jamini Roy will be added in place of repeat content.
- 3. It was agreed by the BOS members that in (BFA509 Advertising Theory III), in Unit-III the topics like Zipping and Zapping, Media Planning and its vehicles these topics are not so relevant and it should be replaced with some introduction of great advertising personalities like David Ogilvy, Piyush Pandey, Prasoon Joshi, Sonal Dabral, Rajiv Rao, Ashish Khazanchi, KV Sridhar and other contemporary artists as per changing advertising culture.
- 4. It was agreed by the BOS members that in (BFA609 Advertising Theory IV), in Unit-I the topics like Economics Advertising and its sub topics like effects of advertising on production, distribution, consumer prices etc are not so relevant and it should be replaced with some introduction of Great Advertising agencies in Indian and Abroad and there brief history and achievements. It should include O&M, McCaan, Publicis, Ulka, Contract, JWT, Mudra etc.
- 5. BOS Members has agreed that the candidate can write his /her Ph.D Thesis In Hindi language because it is approved by UGC and many Central Universities have permission to write thesis in Hindi.
- 6. Value added course (silk screen printed) will be introduced in BFA 1st &IInd Semester. The syllabus of Value added course has approved by BOS members.
