  - a. CBCS Syllabus Approved in principle, but the specific courses to be placed under broad heads may be aligned with UGC guidelines, especially on account of *Skill Enhancement Course* and *Generic Electives*
2. Agreed in principle to club CMA (USA) syllabus with B.Com (P) and B.Com(H). However a comprehensive scheme of the same may be crystallised and shared with external members.
3. Agreed, in principle, to start specialization (Logistics and Supply Chain Management) in BBA & MBA with SAFE Express a logistics Company. More such specialisation may be explored to enhance employability of students.

Following modifications are to be incorporated:

Sr. No.	Modifications:
1	Specific constructs of Employability, in terms of Life skills, work skills, etc. Or in terms of KSA framework.
2	Get inputs from CII, as they are involved in improving the quality of education in ITI students
3	Crystallise independent and dependent variables of the study and their approach of measurement.
4	Correlation analysis may be done between employability and outcome variable, i.e. placement of students
5	Work out sampling details to cover a cross-section of population
6	Ensure that while making a selection of traits their logical consistency in selection of traits to be covered in the study

Following are the synopsis modification to be incorporated:
