The meeting started with the welcoming of the chairperson and all the external members. The chairperson apprised the members about the objectives and agenda points of the meeting.

Following agenda points were discussed:

Agenda I: Confirmation of Minutes of Meeting (MOM) held on 29th December 2023.

Agenda I1: Revision in the syllabus

(A) Reconstruction of the curriculum and syllabus for B.Sc. Forensic Science, according to NEP commencing from session 2024-25

Discussions and Resolutions:

The following points were observed by the board to be examined and recommended as per the need of the program:

- The expert suggested that the course titles for the ability enhancement courses listed in the fourth, fifth, and sixth semesters should correspond to instrumental techniques such as microscopy, chromatography, and spectroscopy, etc., rather than Instrumentation 1, 2, or 3.
- The expert observed that the course codes, which are quite lengthy to be remembered, should also be reviewed, whether they will remain the same for the following year or they will change annually, committee preferred the decision for the Academic Council meeting as the matter is administrative in nature. The finalization of codes for the suffix "P" for practical and "T" for theory courses should also be decided by the management, suggested by the committee. The theory and practical course codes differ; therefore, they might be counted as separate courses, which would push the overall number of courses above the permeability limit. Code splitting ought to be completed using the ERP site.
- In order to address the issue of theoretical and practical, the former might be of three credits, and the latter of one credit. It should be presented with the same code, with the suffix "P" for practical courses and "T" for theory courses, if possible. All the changes may be explored as per the guidelines of the University, the expert suggested.

- The internship should be provided in the fifth semester (minimum seven days) and seventh semester (minimum fifteen days); followed by a minor project in the sixth semester and a major project in eighth semester to enhance the practical skills and exposure.
- Project total should be determined based on credits.
- The student must complete a 4-credit vocational internship in order to get their diploma and certificate upon graduation.
- The course has to be examined for plagiarism and resemblances.
- Minor courses pool is recommended to be decided according to recruitment rules for better employment for the students.
- Topics like biochemistry and microbiology are related to biology in some way and ought to be offered and included in biology minor.
- Since computer science is necessary for those who want to work in cyber security or digital forensics, it may be offered as a minor, if required.
- If toxicology is added as a minor, its syllabus should be explored and maintained in the pertinent semester in accordance with the syllabus's progression from basics to principles to mechanisms.
- If biochemistry is added as a minor, then, the chronology of the courses should be in order.
- The PBL category's "Forensic case study" is inappropriate; and suggested to update it as PBL with a detailed procedure.
- In the contemporary context, MOOCs are essential for students, and must be included in the curriculum at some point.
- Crime Scene Management" would be a better title for the interdisciplinary course "Crime Scene Investigation." The expert advised to change it.
- Since PSOs 3 and 4 seem less appropriate, they ought to be reviewed, also suggested by the expert.

Agenda 1: Confirmation of Minutes of Meeting (MOM) held on 29th December 2023.

Agenda I1: Revision in the syllabus

(A) Reconstruction of the curriculum and syllabus for B.Sc. Forensic Science, according to NEP commencing from session 2024-25

Discussions & Resolutions

During the meeting Prof. (Dr.) Ruchi Kant explained the points of BOS and the committee member unanimously recommended/not recommended the points in the following manner.

- The recommendations made by the members of the BOS committee to expand the instrumentation portion to include microscopy, chromatography, and spectroscopy in the fourth, fifth, and sixth semesters, respectively, have been approved by all members of the BOF.
- Regarding the codes of the paper to change every year or not or it's simplification, the committee preferred the decision for the Academic Council meeting as the matter is administrative in nature. The finalization of codes for the suffix "P" for practical and "T" for theory courses should also be decided by the management, suggested by the committee. The committee recommended to keep theory for 3 credits and practical for 1 credit. The course codes may be kept separately but should be projected appropriately during the result.
- The committee considered the suggestions of BOS expert and recommended to keep internship in the fifth semester (minimum seven days) and seventh semester (minimum fifteen days); a minor project in the sixth semester and a major project in eighth semester to enhance the practical skills and exposure.

- The BOF committee reached a consensus that, students may be granted a UG certificate (1year) or UG Diploma (2year) if they have earned the required 4 credits of vocational training, in both semesters II (certificate prog) and IV (diploma prog) with 44+4 and 92+4 credits, respectively.
- The BOF committee also recommended to check the syllabus for any similarity or plagiarism.
- The BOF committee accepted the BOS recommendations to include topics like microbiology and biochemistry to the minor pool of biology disciplines.
- As forensic toxicology and associated material are already covered in major subjects, the BOF committee acknowledged the BOS recommendations, meaning that the necessity to teach toxicology has been met. The committee further stated that the syllabus should be reviewed in accordance with the chronology, starting with fundamentals and moving on to principles and mechanisms.
- Regarding the addition of Computer Science as a minor subject, the committee suggested that Cyber forensic and related content-have already been included in the Major subjects, a suitable decision to include computer science as a minor subject, may be taken at a later stage based on the requirement of the students and department.
- The committee agreed on the point that the minor subjects should be checked according to the recruitment rules of forensic science.
- In the PBL category (Sem. III & IV), the committee recommended to keep PBL with an operating procedure that will help the students to explore the new problems and their solutions.
 - All BOF and BOS members agreed on the point to add MOOC's in B.Sc. Forensic Sciences Semester VIII.
- The BOF committee also recommended to change the course "Crime Scene Investigation" as "Crime Scene Management".
- PSO's and PO's are aligned according to Bloom's Taxonomy. It is recommended that PSO4 be removed because it is deemed inappropriate in light of the content, whereas PSO3 is corrected as Interdisciplinary collaboration and problem solving.
- Final syllabus after incorporating the suggestions of BOS and BOF is annexed (Annexure 1).
